## A Message from Holy Spirit's School Advisory Board

The Holy Spirit School Advisory Board will hold their annual election in May. Here is some information about our Advisory Board:

- The Board has nine members.
- Members hold a seat for a three-year term.
- Board members must either have a student attending Holy Spirit School or be a member of the Holy Spirit Parish. At least eight of our members must also be practicing Catholics.
- We act as a sounding board for our Pastor and our Principal; we advise and make recommendations.
- We work to promote the school throughout the community.
- We run at least two fundraisers each year, including the Annual Fund and the Walk-a-Thon (which raise money for tuition assistance).
- We also host annual events such as the annual "Welcome Back to School" Open House and the Winter Open House (for new student registrations).

Our meetings are held on the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00pm from August through June. Because we are a very active board, it is extremely important that each and every one of our members be active participants at both our meetings and our events.
